

## House Wines White

1. *Les Petits Grains Blanc, Dom. Bergon 2005 - France* (1) £12.95  
Pale yellow with green highlights, very fruity and elegant on the nose with floral notes, and a dry finish.
2. *Moulin d'Arvie Blanc - France* (4) £12.95  
A deliciously fruity medium white wine from the heart of France.

## White Wines

5. *Chardonnay Estate Collection Aresti 2006 - Chile* (2) £14.95  
Ripe pear and apple aromas are well-balanced with light, vanilla and buttery notes. The long finish is rich with elegant vanilla flavours.
6. *Semillon/Chardonnay Aldridge Estate 2006 - Australia* (3) £15.50  
Passion fruit and melon character dominant on the nose. The palate is full-flavoured with citric and peach fruits.
7. *Pinot Grigio la Casada 2006 - Italy* (2) £14.95  
A medium bodied but dry white with fresh fruit flavours, a touch of spice and a light nuttiness.
8. *Sauvignon Blanc, Fairfields 2006 - New Zealand* (1) £17.50  
This wine shows good ripe flavours of passion fruit along with the distinctive herbal, nettle edges of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc.
9. *Petit Chablis, Dom. Bachelier 2004 - France* (2) £17.95  
Clean fresh chardonnay nose with a pleasing youthful appeal.

*To assist you there is a sweetness scale: 1 to 7 with 1 being the driest*

## House Wines Red & Rosé

3. *Les Petits Grains Rouge 2005 - France* (B) £12.95  
A subtle wine with a balanced fruity flavour.
4. *Les Petits Grains Rosé 2006 - France* (2) £12.95  
Light and refreshing easy drinking rosé.  
Made from 80% Cinsault and 20% Grenache.

## Champagne

10. *Gruet Cuvée Tradition Brut N.V. - France -* (2) £26.95  
100% Pinot Noir, generous & well structured good length on palate.  
A classic example on how a small Champagne House can produce a quality bubbly.

## Red Wines

12. *Cabernet Sauvignon Estate Collection Aresti - Chile* (A) £14.95  
Rich and youthful fruit on the nose and palate.
13. *Merlot/Shiraz Aldridge Estate - Australia* (A) £15.50  
Ripe, peppery fruit on the nose with hints of spice. The palate is full-flavoured with plum, blackberry and integrated oak characters, and soft tannins.
14. *Nero d'Avola la Casada - Italy* (B) £14.95  
Ruby-red colour with intense and brilliant reflections. This wine is intense with sensations of tobacco and spices as well as mineral note in the nose.
15. *Crianza Rioja Alta, Navajas 2004 - Spain* (B) £18.95  
A powerful wine displaying spicy, balsamic aromas combined with rich fruits and toasty smoky hints. A long, lingering sensation of smoothness and elegance.
16. *Beaujolais, Dom. E. Mandrillon 2005 - France* (D) £15.95  
This is wonderfully fruity Beaujolais with good body. A strong fruity nose and strawberry flavours.
